PILLAR 5 PLANNING FOR SUPERVISION AND CONTINUING TRAINING

Supervision of CAHWs is important to:

- Guarantee the quality of services provided to livestock keepers;
- Strengthen the motivation of CAHWs and the relationship of trust between CAHWs and their supervisor;
- ➡ Encourage acceptance and support from local veterinary authorities and communities;
- → Encourage their institutional recognition.

Favour linking CAHWs to a private vet or VPP to ensure regular and sustainable supervision and mentoring:

- CAHWs visit the vet/VPP for resupply and technical advice;
 Vet/VPPs collaborating with CAHWs
- Vet/VPPs collaborating with CAHWs expand the geographical coverage of their services and inputs sales, hence expanding their customer base.

Win-win situation:

CAHWs and vets/VPPs work in a complementary rather than competitive manner.

Select a supervisor who demonstrates good interpersonal skills and willingness to mentor CAHWs.



You may consider providing supervisors with some basic training on human resource management, communication, etc.


